All open burning is controlled by this standard.

1. **Size of Pile:** Pile may not exceed 6 feet in any direction measured horizontally or 3 feet measure vertically.
2. **Location of Pile:** Pile shall be at least 50 feet from any structure, wood or lumber pile, wooden fence, trees or bushes. Provisions shall be made to prevent the fire from spreading closer than within 50 feet of such items or fire shall otherwise be contained in an approved incinerator or burner device which is located at least 30 feet from any structure, wood or lumber pile, wooden fence, trees or bushes.
3. **Material for Burning:** Dry material only, not ignited with flammable or combustible liquids.
4. **Material Shall Not Include:** Rubbish, garbage, trash, or any material made of, or coated with, rubber, plastic, leather, or petroleum based products. The material may not contain any flammable or combustible liquids.
5. **Supervision:** A competent person shall attend the fire, at least 18 years of age, until the fire is extinguished.
6. **Time of Burn:** 8:00 a.m. until 10:00 p.m. with a three hour window stated on the permit application.
8. **The Site** may be inspected prior to issuance of a permit.
9. **Permit Will Be Revoked** if any complaints are received and these guidelines are not followed. Citations will be issued.

By issuance of this permit, the property owner is agreeing to use all possible care in setting of any fire under this permit, and to be responsible for all damage done by such fire. If inclement weather, such as high winds or rains, prevents me from burning the above described fire within the time limit prescribed by this burning permit, that I may apply for an extension of this burning permit by permission from the appropriate fire department issuing this permit.
